



6. The first woman Eve, by the very interpretation of her name, is “the mother of all living” (Gen. 3:20).
7. Adam was the beginning of human civilization before the flood; Noah was the beginning of human civilization after the flood.
8. Adam is called the “first” man, which contradicts any notion that a civilization of men (human) existed before Adam. (1 Corinthians 15:45)
9. In conclusion, there is no Scriptural support for a pre-Adamic human race. Neither is there any hint of such in the writings of Jane Lead, John Pordage, Jacob Boehme, or William Law. And while some writers and ministers indeed expostulate a pre-Adamic human race, this teaching tends to lead people away from the veracity of the Holy Scriptures, and ultimately away from the veracity of the teachings and faith of the Lord Jesus Christ.
