- 2** Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils; (1Ti 4:1)
- 3** And he taketh with him Peter and James and John, and began to be sore amazed, and to be very heavy; (Mar 14:33)
- 4** But covet earnestly the best gifts: and yet shew I unto you a more excellent way. (1Co 12:31)
