True vs False Apostles and Prophets

*The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy:
I am come that they might have life... (John 10:10)*

The Christian Church has *always* been subjected to unregenerate men and women professing to be apostles and prophets of God.¹ Today we are witnessing an explosion of this phenomenon, and a plethora of *pretenders* to the Throne and Kingdom of our Lord. While Christians yet living under God's Grace might easily be led astray by these false ones, Spirit-led believers will have no problem distinguishing between the True and the False. Neither will they go along with the crowd;² for they have intimate union and communion with the Spirit of Christ that leads them into ALL truth.³ Therefore these Holy Seekers and Loving Inquirers are often loners: for they have lost everyone because of their absolute loyalty and obedience to their God. And because their brethren are most uncomfortable with their presence, ultimately these Holy Ones will have to leave their assemblies: For the Enemy will not tolerate them in HIS Church.⁴

*It is good to see with our own eyes: but he that seeth with the eyes of another [or he that depends upon another's words], is always in doubt whether the spirit be true or false. Therefore it is good to have the Noble Stone [which Abraham, Moses, the prophets and apostles had],⁵ that gives assurance, and pointeth at the false Magi. (Jacob Boehme, *The Three-Fold Life*, 3FL 7:55-56)*

For Christians that are yet waiting in their own *Jerusalem*, time will tell whether those prophets and apostles truly possess the *Hope of Glory* within. In the meantime God's faithful sojourners are always obedient to test for a hint of the Lord's sweet fragrance in those that presume to be the Lord's messengers.⁶ No perfume means no fruit;⁷ No fruit means no Life;⁸ No Life means they are not the Lord's servants,⁹ but are instead prophets of the Great Adversary of God's people.¹⁰ Tragically, few Christians are able to distinguish between the foul stench of the Enemy and the Lord's beautiful, sweet fragrance.¹¹ They have either lost their sense of smell—or they never had it in the first place.

*A divine love, as the blossom and fragrance in every fruit of the Spirit, is that which above all marks those who have entered into this Baptism which Christ gives. There is nothing that so much exalts our Lord to His true place in our hearts as this heavenly love. It cleanses and purifies like a holy fire, and all selfish desires fall away before it. Everything that is good and holy grows out of it, and it becomes a continual source of all virtue and pious practices. (William Law, *The Power of the Spirit*, Ch. 11)*

2 Spirit's Day Studies – True vs False Apostles and Prophets

The Mystery of Redemption

Most Christians believe they already understand the Great Mystery of God's Redemption: *That Jesus Christ was born of a virgin, lived a sinless life, died on the cross, resurrected on the third day, ascended into Heaven, and is now glorified and sitting upon His Father's Throne.*¹² All this being very clear to them, they see no need to investigate further. But this knowledge is only what man is able to receive on an *elementary* level; yet it hardly scratches the surface of all that is implied and available under God's Master Plan.¹³ For the *hidden things of God*¹⁴ are not perceived through the *Letter* of the Word. Holy Seekers and Loving Inquirers must dive deep into the *Spirit* of the Mystery.¹⁵ They *must* investigate that which the Spirit of God is *sending* them to learn.¹⁶ That is, the *Letter* of the Word must be *eaten down and digested*, so that the *Spirit* of the Word may bring forth its Life.¹⁷

Taste and see that the LORD is good: blessed is the man that trusteth in him. (Psa. 34:8)

Here you may believe a table is most richly furnished, in the most high and excellent degree, for all of the Lord Christ's Ascending Eagles, which cannot be satisfied with any other prey, but to feed upon the glorified Body, which is filled with all the fullness of God, which flows largely into them, whose vessels are here prepared. Christ in You: The Grand Mystery

It must clear that without the *Gift of the Father*, this Mystery cannot be fully opened or comprehended. For the indwelling Spirit of the Resurrected Christ not only *reveals* the Mystery—it *contains* the Mystery! The Indwelling Christ *is the Mystery!*¹⁸ Our total and full redemption *is in the Mystery!*

There shall be a total and full redemption by CHRIST. This is an hidden mystery, not to be understood without the *Revelation* of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is at hand to *reveal* the same to all Holy Seekers and Loving Inquirers. (Jane Lead, *60 Propositions*, 1-3)

And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory. (1Ti 3:16)

For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren. Moreover whom he did predestinate, them he also called: and whom he called, them he also justified: and whom he justified, them he also glorified. (Rom 8:29-30)

It is truly tragic that this Great and Precious Promise is almost entirely absent in the Church today.¹⁹ For this Gift of the Holy Ghost is an absolute requirement for our continued and progressive growth *in Christ.*²⁰ Without this *Inward Messenger of Truth*, the false is not so easily identified. For this very reason the modern Church has witnessed an explosive outbreak of *delusion*, with false “anointed ones” multiplying more and more, claiming to be prophets and apostles of the Lord.²¹ Christian apologists, researchers, and discernment ministers place the blame on the false leaders themselves—which is reasonable. But they seem not to be able to understand how so many Christians are being led astray. Therefore they also accuse the brethren of having “itching ears;” that follow every wind of deceptive doctrine. But these watchmen and women must bear some responsibility. For they have led their brothers and sisters to believe that they have what they have not; that they received what they did not.²² As well, Christians have also *allowed* themselves to be deceived;²³ and must therefore bear their own measure of responsibility for their deception.²⁴

And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved.²⁵ For this cause God shall send them strong delusion, that they should believe a lie: (2Th 2:10-11)

Law vs Life

Two stumbling blocks prevent Christians from recognizing these false messengers: One is *the Law*; the other is *the Life*. The Old Testament criterion is found in the *Law*; New Testament criterion is found in the *Life*. Old Testament Law required prophecy to be fulfilled precisely as delivered.²⁶ New Testament Law requires a *Life* that agrees precisely with that of the Lord Jesus Christ.²⁷ Herein is the problem: The Church is using Old Testament criterion to identify and test a New Testament prophet. Old Testament prophets *carried* a message. New Testament prophets *carry* a *Life* and a *message*! False Prophets in the Old Testament were stoned;²⁸ New Testament false prophets are to be cast out of the assembly.²⁹ So how can the Church use the Old Testament *test*—but not the Old Testament *punishment*? Because the Old Testament test alone was *never* designed for New Testament prophets!

Again, the rules for detecting these false ones in the New Covenant are not the same as in the Old. Here is the key: False Leaders do not possess *The Life*! No indwelling means no Christ. No Christ means no New Covenant! This demonstrates how a Christian, while living in New Testament times, can still be living under the (mystical/inward) Old Testament Law. For the indwelling Life of the Spirit of the Resurrected Christ *is the New Covenant*! Christians without the true and right baptism of the Spirit of Christ are not yet the New Creation IN Christ Jesus! They may be living under the grace of the New, but until the Life of Christ becomes a birth within—though saved, the Christian has not yet received New Covenant-Life. He may be born of the Word but he must also be born of the Spirit—which is not often concurrent with initial conversion.³⁰

God's Nature Within

Since there is so little true Spirit and discernment among Christians today, it is no wonder that false teachers, false prophets and false apostles have *overtaken* the Church—some even desiring to take the world by force. And as the Holy Spirit is largely absent (or rather *banished* by Christians), the false ones continue to breed more and more false ones; so that the Church we once knew and loved no longer exists. It has become the Babylon spoken of by the Holy Seer.³¹

As you cautiously observe them, in whatsoever setting, can you imagine the Holy Jesus, who *was* and *is* the True image of the Father? Can you picture your apostles or prophets *as Jesus*? Do they bear the *character* of the Lord, the *humility* of the Lord, the Grace, Mercy, Love, and Compassion of the Lord and Savior Jesus—who was, and is, and always will be the *express image* of God's own person?³² True Prophets and Apostles of the Lord *will bear* the *express image* of the person of the Lord Jesus Christ!³³ This is the first and most elementary test. And if they cannot pass this test, then you need go no further with them. For the true Prophets and Apostles will have so much of God's nature in them they cannot be viewed as anything other than the Lord's faithful and just servants.³⁴

The Hope of Glory

False prophets, apostles, and teachers *cannot* display the nature of God and Christ—*because it is not in them*! They cannot manifest what they do not possess. They can only offer a counterfeit that is easily identified by a soul that has learned to walk with the Lord in all faith and obedience. The false will always attract the false. *But the holy will always be drawn to the holy*! Therefore the Holy Seeker and Loving Inquirer **MUST** have the Spirit of Christ; for this **ALONE** is your Hope of Glory!³⁵ There is no other path, no other way, no other hope—than to possess this Indwelling *Messenger* and *Performer* of all the wonderful deeds of the Lord our God. He is your guide *into* all that is Truth; and the *only* protection against all that is false and evil.

4 Spirit's Day Studies – True vs False Apostles and Prophets

Testing the Prophets

True Apostles and Prophets will not act or speak on their own initiative; but will *only* speak what is given them from God.³⁶ And as they are specifically sent by the Lord, they will only draw attention to the Lord Jesus Christ and His Gospel—not to themselves or their “ministries.” This, too, is an elementary test, but so often ignored by God’s people,³⁷ proving that the modern Church is filled with Christians who have absolutely no discernment in the things of the Spirit of God.³⁸

True vs False Apostles and Prophets:

- ♦ The true are messengers sent by God.³⁹ The false are sent by Satan.⁴⁰
- ♦ The true have the *Birth of Christ* within. The false do not.⁴¹
- ♦ The true have *risen* (inwardly) *with* Christ.⁴² The false do not have or know this Indwelling Christ, and therefore cannot possibly receive this inward resurrection.
- ♦ The true will walk the path that Jesus walked.⁴³ The false will walk their own path.⁴⁴
- ♦ The true are strangers to this world.⁴⁵ The false are not only *of the world*, but by their deeds demonstrate their *love for this world*.⁴⁶
- ♦ The true will have no regard for the material things of this world.⁴⁷ The false will not only covet them, they will accumulate them.⁴⁸
- ♦ The true will behave like Jesus. The false will behave like Satan.⁴⁹
- ♦ The true will have the care and Spiritual growth of their brethren as their utmost concern. The false will not only stifle the growth of their charges, they will keep them ever-dependent on themselves and their “prophetic” utterances.
- ♦ The true will *give* to the flock.⁵⁰ The false will not only *require* their tithes and offerings—they will *steal* them.⁵¹
- ♦ The true will lead their charges into the truth of the Redemption-Life.⁵² The false will lead their charges to destruction.⁵³
- ♦ The true will have so much of the nature of the Lord in them, they cannot do anything but as *God* directs.⁵⁴ The false will have so much of the nature of the Enemy, they can only do as the Enemy directs.⁵⁵
- ♦ The true will walk, talk, and act like Jesus. The false *cannot* walk, talk, or act like the Lord, but can only demonstrate the nature and characteristics of their master.
- ♦ The true will have the Spirit of Christ as a *Birth* and a conscious *Indwelling Presence*, so that they continually *project* God’s Image.⁵⁶ The false have no such birth, and therefore can neither be conformed to Jesus, nor project that which they do not possess.
- ♦ The true will speak only God’s Truth.⁵⁷ The false will speak the lies of the Enemy.⁵⁸
- ♦ The true will have so much of God’s nature in them, they cannot but *manifest* that nature.⁵⁹ The false have no such nature, nor bear any true resemblance to God or Jesus Christ, and can therefore only manifest the nature of the world and the Enemy.⁶⁰
- ♦ The true will lead many Sons to Glory.⁶¹ The false can *never* lead them to glory, but will instead lead them into perdition.⁶²
- ♦ The true will not take away from the flock.⁶³ The false will steal, cheat, abuse, confuse, deceive and betray their flock—for they cannot do otherwise.⁶⁴
- ♦ True Prophets love the Lord God, *and their neighbor*, with all their heart, soul, mind, and strength.⁶⁵ False Prophets love themselves, the praises of men—and especially mammon!⁶⁶

Tests Forsaken

These tests are designed for the benefit of the true, sincere, faithful and loving follower of the Lord Jesus Christ. Therefore, those who will not follow the Lord's warnings, as set forth in the Holy Scriptures by the Spirit of Truth, are as lambs led to the slaughter. The tests mean nothing to them. They will continue to follow those that ravage women (*and children!*), steal tithes and offerings, deliver false prophecies, shout at demons, perform bogus healings—all while claiming they are operating under a “commission” from the Lord. But these false prophets and apostles only bring destruction to both themselves and their followers.⁶⁷ And although some may behave in a more dignified manner, yet they are just as deadly: for they are *idols* in the Church; and those who follow them have become just like them.⁶⁸

They have mouths, but they speak not; eyes have they, but they see not; They have ears, but they hear not; neither is there any breath in their mouths. They that make them are like unto them: so is every one that trusteth in them. (Psa. 135:15-18)

These false ones are the Enemy's cohorts, who not only to lead the faithful astray (if possible), but gather up the world (non-believers) into a community that *counterfeits* the true and holy Church of the Lord Jesus Christ.

As the world in age grows old, so the Mystery of Iniquity will wax greater, by putting on and counterfeiting the very robe of Christ's innocence and truth. (AS 38b)

These come abroad with unmortified lusts, imperious wills, imposing principles in contempt of the humility, simplicity, and plainness of the doctrine of Christ, and of the self-denial, charity and love in the practice of Christianity, but will be teachers of the multitude, yet being ignorant of God, of nature, and of themselves; being very great strangers to Christ, in whom only are all the treasures of True Wisdom. (Boehme's 177 *Theosophic Questions*, Q149:9)

And as the division between the godly and the profane grows greater, and as the wicked become more bold (in the Church), so too, the true Christian will become more noticeable—and will therefore be *completely intolerable* to a Church that has wholly rejected the True Spirit of the Resurrected Christ! For as evil waxes worse and worse, so the faithful ones are becoming a rarity indeed.⁶⁹ And as their obedience, faithfulness, and devotion to the Lord is known and witnessed, the despisers of God, the false Christians—and even lukewarm Christians—will hate their presence in their assemblies. For persecution *always* follows the Lord's Faithful Ones.⁷⁰

Letter vs Spirit

Sincere believers in the Lord Jesus Christ understand that God's Redemption-Plan is a Mystery. But precisely *how* this Mystery is to be accomplished in the soul is an even Greater Mystery; which can only be thoroughly perceived, apprehended, and attained by the Gift of the Spirit of Christ. To understand the *letter* of this Mystery is necessary and commendable. But to understand the *Spirit* of the Mystery is that which will differentiate between the lukewarm Christian, and the Christian who is pressing hard after Mark and Prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus.⁷¹ †††
